FOIA 22-16601-F requested all photos of Netflix CEO Reed Hastings.

This FOIA primarily contains photographs of President Obama and Vice President Biden meeting with executives from leading tech companies in the Roosevelt Room on December 17, 2013; President Obama meeting with Internet CEOs in the Oval Office on March 21, 2014; and President Obama, First Lady Michelle Obama, President Xi Jinping of China, and Madame Peng Liyuan greeting State Dinner guests in the Blue Room on September 25, 2015.

## **System of Arrangement**

The materials in FOIA 22-16601-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Records responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – Obama Presidential Electronic Records.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Obama administration staff. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.
