Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 23-39824-F are a selective, not necessarily all-inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

FOIA 23-39824-F requested materials related to the 14th Amendment or \$1 trillion coin for use on the Debt Ceiling/Debt Limit, and a memorandum from the Office of Legal Counsel to the White House in 2011.

This FOIA primarily contains correspondence with Congress and the Department of the Treasury, case opinions and summaries, published articles, opinion pieces, scholarly papers, and congressional records and testimonies.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 23-39824-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – Staff Member Office Files and the Obama Presidential Electronic Records.

Staff Member Office Files are maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. Staff Member Office Files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of

documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Obama administration staff. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.
