Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 22-21458-F.5 are a selective, not necessarily all-inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

FOIA 22-21458-F.5 requested all raw video footage shot by White House Videographers Arun Chaudhary, Hope Hall, and any other official videographer working in the White House during the Obama Administration.

This FOIA primarily contains footage filmed by the White House videographer from trips President Obama took to Elkhart, Indiana, on February 2, 2009, and Ottawa, Canada, on February 19, 2009. Footage from the Elkhart trip includes remarks by the President at the Monaco RV Factory. Footage in Ottawa includes remarks by the President at the U.S. Embassy, meeting with Canadian leaders, shopping at a local mall, and travel.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 22-21458-F.5 are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas - White House Communications Agency.

White House Communications Agency records are processed at the folder/videotape level. While this method maintains folder/videotape integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of videotapes that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
