FOIA 22-18402-F requested audiovisual communications between President Obama and Dr. Anthony Fauci, the NIH, CDC, or National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Disease.

This FOIA primarily contains footage of President Obama visiting and delivering remarks at the National Institute of Health in Bethesda, Maryland, and the Centers for Disease Control in Atlanta, Georgia, on September 16, 2014.

### **System of Arrangement**

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas - White House Communications Agency.

White House Communications Agency records are processed at the folder/videotape level. While this method maintains folder/videotape integrity, it frequently results in

the incidental processing of videotapes that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
