The materials in FOIA 22-16542-F are a selective, not necessarily all-inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

FOIA 22-16542-F requested materials related to the FBI and Department of Justice's Cold Case Initiative, the Emmett Till Unsolved Civil Rights Crime Act, and the Emmett Till Unsolved Civil Rights Crimes Reauthorization Act.

This FOIA primarily contains correspondence, memoranda, reports and asset lists.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 22-16542-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – Obama Presidential Electronic Records and White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Files

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Obama administration staff. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home

and shared drives used by White House staff.

The WHORM Subject File was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and consists of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. Electronic Records

Exchange Email - Other - Till Act contains 3 assets, of which 2 are released in full, and 1 is withheld in part.

Exchange Email - Presidential - Till Act contains 470 assets, of which 161 are released in full, 16 are withheld in part, and 293 are withheld in full.

Shared Drive - NSC contains 7 assets, of which 1 are released in full, and 6 are withheld in full.

Shared Drive - OA contains 6 assets, of which 5 are released in full, and 1 is withheld in full.

Shared Drive - WHO contains 154 assets, of which 71 are released in full, and 83 are withheld in full.
