Scope and Content Note

Photos from the State Dinner in honor of China at the White House on September 25, 2015. The State Dinner honored President Xi Jinping of China and Madame Peng Liyuan.

There are photos of President Jinping's arrival; a reception in the Yellow Oval room and on the Truman Balcony; greeting guests in the Blue Room; President Obama and President Jinping delivering remarks and toasts; and a performance by Ne-Yo.

System of Arrangement

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Obama administration staff. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as the White House Photo System.

The photographs are a subseries of a larger series, which includes all photographs taken by White House photographers during the Obama administration. This subseries is arranged chronologically by the photo identifier (P number), which is formatted as PMDDYYXX-####:

- P (for Presidential photographs)
- MMDDYY (Date of image capture)
- XX (Photographer's initials)

- Frame number
