FOIA 24-25188-F requested materials related to White House spokeswoman Caitlin Hayden's statement to ProPublica, around July 2013, concerning the closure of the NSC review of the Dasht-i-Leili massacre.

This FOIA primarily contains email correspondence between White House spokeswoman Caitlin Hayden and ProPublica regarding the Dasht-e-leili massacre.

System of Arrangement

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – Obama Presidential Electronic Records

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Obama administration staff. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.
