Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 24-45381-F (segment 1) are a selective, not necessarily all-inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

FOIA 24-45381-F (segment 1) requested all White House photographs taken in 2009. This segment of the FOIA contains photographs from January 21, 2009, through February 21, 2009. Photos from this time frame have been released through other FOIAs.

This FOIA primarily contains photographs of briefings, meetings, signings, calls, trips, and video tapings from January 21, 2009, through February 21, 2009. There are photos from the Lilly Ledbetter Fair Pay Act signing, President Obama's trip to Ottawa, Canada, and a Celebration of African American History Month.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 24-45381-F (segment 1) are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – Obama Presidential Electronic Records.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Obama administration staff. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.
