Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 22-17709-F are a selective, not necessarily all-inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

FOIA 22-17709-F requested correspondence and financial records related to the Brain Research Through Advancing Innovative Neurotechnologies (BRAIN) Initiative.

This FOIA primarily contains correspondence, briefing papers, speeches, remarks, and proclamations. Textual records consist of briefing papers containing the Presidential schedule, memoranda, and background information such as event summaries, guest lists, and participant bios; letters from POTUS to organizations, groups, and members of the public pertaining to the the BRAIN Initiative; and speeches, remarks, and proclamations related to health, mental diseases, the BRAIN Initiative, and science and medicine.

System of Arrangement

The materials in FOIA 22-17709-F are a systematic body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult an archivist about related materials.

Documents responsive to this FOIA were found in these collection areas – White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Files and Obama Presidential Electronic Records.

WHORM Subject and WHORM Alpha Files are processed at the document level.

The WHORM Alpha File was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of documents arranged by name of persons, organizations, or events.

The WHORM Subject File was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and consists of a series of documents assigned a letter/number combination and filed in a subject category. A complete listing of the subject categories, including a detailed description of each category, is available on the National Archives Catalog.

The Executive Office of the President (EOP) instance of the Electronic Records Archive (ERA) contains electronic records created or received by Obama administration staff. These records are stored in Search and Access Sets (SAS) that represent their originating computer program, such as Exchange Email or the Worker and Visitor Entry System (WAVES). In addition to records captured from the White House's electronic systems, EOP-ERA also contains records from the home and shared drives used by White House staff.

- *Exchange - Presidential - BRAIN Initiative* contains 1969 assets, of which 999 are released in full, 87 are withheld in part, and 883 are withheld in full.
- *Shared Drive - NSC - BRAIN Initiative* contains 80 assets, of which 11 are released in full and 69 are withheld in full.
- *Shared Drive - OA - BRAIN Initiative* contains 18 assets, of which 10 are released in full and 8 are withheld in full.
