The HIRE Act provides tax incentives for hiring and retaining unemployed workers; includes a tax credit to increase expensing of certain depreciable business assets; expands upon the Build America Bonds model; and extends surface transportation programs through the end of the year.

Taara has worked this past year on the hiring and on boarding of all White House staff. Taara co-founded the Professional Development Series for all White House staff. This program focuses on career development and includes a monthly speaker series, educational forums, and a pilot mentorship program. There are over 160 active participants in this Professional Development series. Taara also spearheaded a major work-life initiative, LifeCare, to increase work-life balance and provide emergency backup childcare for all employees of the Executive Office of the President.

During the campaign, Taara was the Youth Vote Director in New Hampshire. Taara developed the youth voter education program for 18 to 24 year olds in 15 colleges in the state.
