Close hold information:

I just spoke with D/FBI and Assistant AG Kris. FBI served a search warrant this afternoon at the NYC residence of Najibullah Zazi cohort Adis Medunjunin, who has been under 24/7 FBI coverage over the past several months. The search warrant was for his passport. He turned over his passport but immediately afterward got into his car, drove erratically and at a high rate of speed, crashed into another vehicle, and tried to flee the scene. Trailing FBI agents chased and tackled him, mirandized him, and put him under arrest for the accident.

After he was mirandized, Adis started to rant that he was on a jihad and was trying to kill as many people as possible. Apparently, he made a martyrdom statement during a 911 call immediately prior to getting into his car, saying that he was trying to kill as many people as possible.

He was taken into custody and has been talking about the training he received in what he said was a TTP (Baitullah Masud) camp in Pakistan. He is still talking, including about Zazi and at least one other individual in the NYC "Zazi group," an individual we also have been tracking. Again, these admissions took place after he was mirandized.

Current plan is to indict him tomorrow on felony charges, which could include terrorism/murder. DOJ/FBI anticipates that the other individual (Zareen) likely will be indicted or will plead tomorrow as well.

This could hit the press at anytime, although DOJ/FBI is trying to keep this under wraps until tomorrow.

Will advise further developments.
