Subject: Noble Eagle Event

A single-engine plane has been flying unpiloted over continental United States, as the pilot is apparently unconscious and slumped over the controls. Departed Cincinnati, OH at approximately 1000hrs EDT and was heading south at an altitude of 25,000 ft. It is currently spiraling down and out of control near Muncie, Indiana. Emergency units are responding to area. Impact could occur at any time, looks like over unpopulated area.
