"The president is deeply saddened by the loss of life resulting from these deplorable and cowardly attacks, and sends his condolences to the people of Uganda and the loved ones of those who have been killed or injured. The United States is ready to provide any assistance requested by the Ugandan government."

On background we are saying:

- we are in touch with our Embassy in Uganda and in touch with the FBI regarding Government of Uganda requests for assistance

Press now reporting over 50 dead as well as a third blast. No claim of responsibility yet.

FBI deploying some folks from Nairobi, South Africa, and CONUS. The team will include a bomb tech, evidence response team members, and investigators. Our assistance has been officially requested by the Ugandan govt thru the US Ambassador. FBI local response is being coordinated through the Legatt's office in Nairobi. FBI will coord with the other USG elements in Nairobi and Kampala.
