Fire aboard USS Miami nuclear submarine in Portsmouth, NH has just been put out. Six firefighters and first responders sustained minor injuries. Fire was in crew living quarters and command and control rooms. Nuclear propulsion plant spaces were never affected by fire.

Subject: Submarine Fire

A fire broke out in the forward compartment of a Navy Nuclear Submarine drydocked in Portsmouth, NH, causing injuries to crew and emergency responders. Reactor is in separate compartment in rear of the vessel and has not been affected. There are no weapons on board and reactor was shut down when fire occurred. Fire not yet fully extinguished. Denis and I are monitoring developments and will advise when all clear.
