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Subject: More Tornado Activity in Oklahoma

Sir – A large tornado touched down 28 miles west of Oklahoma City. A Tornado Warning has been issued, which includes the western suburbs of the Oklahoma City metropolitan area (just north of the Moore recovery area). FEMA suspended recovery field operations in Moore, OK earlier this afternoon. The Storm Prediction Center has issued a moderate risk for strong tornadoes through tonight across central/eastern Oklahoma, southeast Kansas, and southwest Missouri (including Joplin). We are continuing to monitor and will provide updates as appropriate.
