I just wanted to give you a head's up that we have a 13 year old patient at Lurie Children's in Chicago who arrived here from Liberia on 11/15, and now has fever, and is being tested for ebola. We will get the result at 8-10pm tonight.

This is a low risk case, the sort we get 2-3x / day, and I usually DON'T alert on these, but I wanted to flag it for you because it is our first in Chicago.
