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Subject: Tropical Storm Andrea - Update

Sir – Tropical Storm Andrea made landfall around 5:40 PM EDT in Dixie County, Florida (pop. 16,486), about 160 miles north of Tampa, Florida, and continues to move inland. At the time of landfall, Andrea had maximum sustained winds of 65 mph, but as of earlier this evening had decreased to 50 mph due to interaction with land. Rains and winds will continue to spread northward along the southeastern U. S. coast tonight and Friday. A Tornado Watch was issued for the Florida Peninsula until 10:00 PM EDT this evening. The primary effects will be heavy rainfall, minor storm surge, isolated tornadoes, and strong rip currents. There have been no requests for FEMA assistance.
