Sir –

The National Hurricane Center just moments ago named Tropical Storm Karen.

TS Karen is currently located in the SE Gulf of Mexico and producing winds of 60MPH.

There is a 100% chance this storm becomes a Tropical Cyclone.

Hurricane and TS watches will be issued for portions of the Northern Gulf Coast. Current forecasts suggest weather will begin to degrade along the northern Gulf Coast in 30-36 hours.

The National Weather Service and FEMA are recalling relevant staff.
