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Subject: Update 3: Winter storm

Sir - update below. We don't believe any calls are needed by you today.

LATEST: The severe weather has moved out of the northeast region leaving behind up to 40 inches of snow and delivering winds up to 83 mph in the New England region. Recovery efforts are ongoing, and State and local responders, power restoration crews and National Guardsman are working to return communities back to normal operating conditions. There are 6 (+4) confirmed storm-related fatalities. FEMA reports there are no unmet needs. As of 2:00 AM EST, there are approximately 383,954 (-244,621) customers without power across Massachusetts, New York, Maine, Connecticut, and Rhode Island.

Stafford Act: On February 10th, the President approved an Emergency Declaration for Connecticut providing emergency protective measures (category B), including direct federal assistance, at 75 percent federal funding, for a period of 48 hours for eight counties and the Tribal Nations of Mashantucket Pequot and Mohegan.

Weather: The National Weather Service reports all blizzard warnings and watches are expired or cancelled.
