Hello Caroline,

We received confirmation for the timing of the Medal of Freedom ceremony on November 22nd, so I wanted to pass along further arrival instructions/next steps:

Arrival Instructions

- Medalists should arrive to the Southeast Gates (15th and Alexander Hamilton Place NW – map is attached) at **11:45AM**. We are asking medalists to come early so we can do a walkthrough of the ceremony. Mr. Michaels is permitted to bring ONE guest with him at this time if he'd like to have someone with him.
- Remaining guests can arrive at the Southeast Gates (15th and Alexander Hamilton Place NW) at **1:00PM**. As a reminder, medalists are allowed to have up to 5 guests with them.

Information to Collect

- Could you please send over the following information by **Wednesday evening**:
 - Security information for Mr. Michaels and his guests using the attached spreadsheet.
 - The names of the guests Mr. Michaels would like in his group photo with the President and First Lady. Mr. Michaels is not required to have guests in his photo.
 - The name and phone number of the best POC to contact Mr. Michael's guests, in case we have trouble finding them when they arrive at 1:00PM.

>upcoming Presidential Medal of Freedom Ceremony.

>Event Details

>• The Presidential Medal of Freedom Ceremony will take place at
>the White House on Tuesday, November 22. A time has not yet been
>determined, so we are asking all medalists to keep their calendar clear
>for the day if possible.

>• The ceremony will take place in the East Room and will last
>approximately one hour with a reception taking place shortly after.

>• All awardees are allowed to bring up to five family members or
>guests to the ceremony. We'll be reaching out shortly to collect their
>names and security information ahead of the event.

>• The press release announcing this year's medalists will likely
>be released mid-November (approximately one or two weeks before the
>ceremony). We'll be sure to notify you in advance and are asking all
>medalists to keep the announcement close-hold until then.

>1. Please provide the full name that you would like on your medal
>and citation.

>2. Do you have any accessibility needs that we can accommodate the
>day of the ceremony?

>3. Are you interested in participating in media interviews while at
>the White House?

>White House's internal video team for use on whitehouse.gov? This would
>also take place at the White House.
