>Event Details

>· The Presidential Medal of Freedom Ceremony will take place at
>the White House on Tuesday, November 22. A time has not yet been
>determined, so we are asking all medalists to keep their calendar clear
>for the day if possible.
>· The ceremony will take place in the East Room and will last
>approximately one hour with a reception taking place shortly after.
>· All awardees are allowed to bring up to five family members or
>guests to the ceremony. We'll be reaching out shortly to collect their
>names and security information ahead of the event.
>· The press release announcing this year's medalists will likely
>be released mid-November (approximately one or two weeks before the
>ceremony). We'll be sure to notify you in advance and are asking all
>medalists to keep the announcement close-hold until then.
