We look forward to welcoming you to Judge Sotomayor's confirmation hearings. Your seat in the hearing room is reserved for tomorrow's session. Please arrive at least 45 minutes early(9:15am), in order to allow time to check in at Room SD 162 and receive your access badge:

As a reminder, the hearings will take place in the Dirksen and Hart Senate Office Buildings, located at First Street SE & Constitution Avenue. After arriving and passing through security, please check in at Room SD 162, on the first floor of the Dirksen Senate Office Building. You will be issued a hearing badge that allows access to Hart Senate Office Building Room 216, where the hearing will be held. In the event you've already received your pass please proceed directly to the hearing room in Hart 216 past the public line to your left and the press stakeout to your right. A member of the Senate Judiciary Committee will check your pass and identity and grant you access to the hearing room. At the end of your time slot, you **MUST** return your security badge to the White House staff, in SD 162. Failure to do so will result in the White House losing one of its seats.

You are discouraged from getting up and leaving in the middle of the hearing. Under no circumstances should anyone speak to a member of the media.
