Moments after Bush 43 exited a side entrance with former First Lady Laura Bush, President Trump and former president Obama appeared at the top of the East Capitol steps at 12:35

Steps were lined with military guards in appropriate rain gear (unlike your poolster). Accompanying the 44th and 45th presidents were VP Pence and former VP Biden, along with wives. All four walked down halfway to the first landing, from where the Pences accompanied the Bidens to their limo.

Trump and the new First Lady walked the Obamas to the helicopter formerly known as Marine One for takeoff.

Revvng engines precluded any sound, words, from 44 and 45.

Trump and Obama shook hands. Trump also kissed Michelle on both cheeks. The women also exchanged hugs.

Michelle got on the chopper first, followed by Obama, who waved from the door, and then also through a window from inside the aircraft.

The Trumps then turned back to the Capitol steps and rejoined the Pences in facing the chopper and waving to the Obamas.

Wheels left the ground at 11:45 for Andrews.

Trump and Melania then made their way back up the steps and inside the Capitol for lunch.

Also on the steps for Obama departure was House Speaker Paul Ryan and Democratic Leader Nancy Pelosi.

Pool, ushered over from the Rose Garden, where we witnessed Obama's final exit from the Oval Office (per pool report #1), was stationed on a riser adjoining the North Portico. Obama and Michelle came out next to greet Trump and Melania.

Obama sported a blue tie, Michelle a maroon dress. Obama pecked her on the cheek and they both

chatted and smiled tightly as the Trump limo pulled up.

Obama waved, "how are you" as Trump emerged from the car in dark suit and red tie.

Melania wore a powder blues dress and matching heels.

She carried a matching colored box containing a present, which Obama carried inside after exchanges of handshakes and kisses.

All 4 lined up for the photographers, before heading inside for the traditional coffee and tea reception, which is closed press.

BIOGRAPHIES FOR MEMBERS OF THE JOINT CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEE ON INAUGURAL CEREMONIES (JCCIC)



Senator Roy Blunt (R) Missouri - JCCIC Chairman

United States Senator Roy Blunt was elected to the United States Senate in 2010. Senator Blunt serves as the Vice Chairman of the Senate Republican Conference. He also serves on the Senate Appropriations Committee; the Senate Commerce, Science and Transportation Committee; and the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence. He is the Chairman of the Senate Rules Committee and Chairman of the Appropriations Subcommittee on Labor, Health and Human Services, Education, and Related Agencies.

Senator Blunt is a member of the Smithsonian Council for American Art and is also a member of the Kennedy Center Board of Trustees.

The Senator is married to Abigail Blunt and has four children: Matt Blunt, Missouri's 54th Governor; Amy Blunt, an attorney in Columbia, Mo.; Andy Blunt, an attorney in Jefferson City; and Charlie (age 11). Blunt has six grandchildren: Davis Mosby, Ben Blunt, Branch Blunt, Eva Mosby, Allyson Blunt, and Brooks Blunt.



Senator Charles Schumer (D) New York - Senate Minority Leader

Chuck was born in Brooklyn, NY and grew up the Sheepshead Bay neighborhood with his siblings, Fran and Robert. Chuck has two daughters, Jessica and Alison, and he still resides in Brooklyn with his wife, Iris Weinshall.

After graduating from Harvard College and Harvard Law School in 1974, Chuck returned home and ran for the New York State Assembly, becoming, at 23, the youngest member of the State Legislature since Theodore Roosevelt. In 1980, at 29, Chuck ran for and won the seat in the 9th Congressional District.

In 1998, Chuck was elected to the U.S. Senate; he became New York's senior senator when Senator Daniel Patrick Moynihan retired in 2000. Following the elections of 2006, Majority Leader Harry Reid (D-NV) appointed Chuck to serve as Vice Chair of the Democratic Conference, the number three position on the Democratic Leadership team and a position he continues to hold. In 2009, Chuck was selected as the Chairman of the Senate Rules Committee, which oversees federal elections, voting rights, campaign finance, and the operation of the Senate complex. After New Yorkers re-elected him for a third term in 2010, Chuck took on an expanded role in the Senate as Chairman of the Democratic Policy and Communications Center.



Senator Mitch McConnell (R) Kentucky - Senate Majority Leader

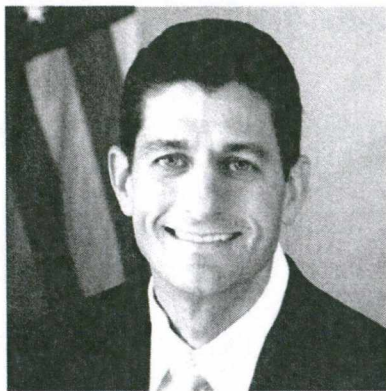
Mitch McConnell has served as U.S. Senate majority leader since 2015.

McConnell previously served as the Republican Leader in the 110th through 113th Congresses, a position he was unanimously elected to by his colleagues every two years since 2006. He also served in leadership as the majority whip during the 108th and 109th Congresses and as chairman of the National Republican

Senatorial Committee during the 1998 and 2000 election cycles.

McConnell is Kentucky's longest-serving senator. First elected to the Senate in 1984, he was elected to a record sixth term in 2014 with broad support from across the commonwealth, winning 110 of Kentucky's 120 counties. McConnell currently serves as a senior member of the Appropriations, Agriculture and Rules Committees.

He is the proud father of three daughters and is married to the Honorable Elaine L. Chao, who served for eight years as President George W. Bush's secretary of labor. Secretary Chao is a former president of the United Way of America and director of the Peace Corps.



Representative Paul D. Ryan (R) Wisconsin - Speaker of the House

Born and raised in the community of Janesville, Paul Ryan is a fifth-generation Wisconsin native. Paul is currently serving his ninth term as a member of Congress.

In October 2015, after then-House Speaker John Boehner retired from Congress, Paul was elected House Speaker. Prior to serving as speaker of the House, Congressman Ryan served as the chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee. During the 112th & 113th Congresses, he served as chairman of the House Budget Committee

Paul is a graduate of Joseph A. Craig High School in Janesville and earned a degree in economics and political science from Miami University in Ohio.

Representative Kevin McCarthy (R) California - House Majority Leader

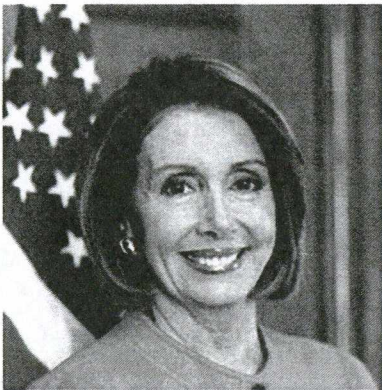


Congressman Kevin McCarthy proudly serves California's 23rd district and is currently the Majority Leader in the U.S. House of Representatives. Kevin was first elected to Congress in 2006 and is a native of Bakersfield and a fourth-generation Kern County resident. The grandson of a cattle rancher and the son of a firefighter, Kevin grew up a working-class family and is committed to preserving and promoting the American dream for hardworking Americans.

At the age of 21, Kevin started his own small business, Kevin O's Deli, from the ground up. He sold his business to put himself through college and graduate school at California State University, Bakersfield. While at school, he interned for Congressman Bill Thomas and later became a member of Congressman Thomas's staff. In 2000, he won his first public election as Trustee to the Kern Community College District and then, in 2002, he was elected to represent the 32nd Assembly District in the California State Assembly. After he was elected to Congress in 2006, Kevin quickly became Chief Deputy Whip and later served as Majority Whip. In 2014, he was elected Majority Leader of the House, where he now leads Congress in fighting for individual liberty, an efficient and effective government, free markets, and a vibrant civil society.

When Kevin is not in Washington, he is home in Bakersfield with his wife Judy and two children Connor and Meghan.

Representative Nancy Pelosi (D) California - House Democratic Leader



Nancy Pelosi is the Democratic Leader of the U.S. House of Representatives for the 115th Congress. From 2007 to 2011, Pelosi served as Speaker of the House, the first woman to do so in American history.

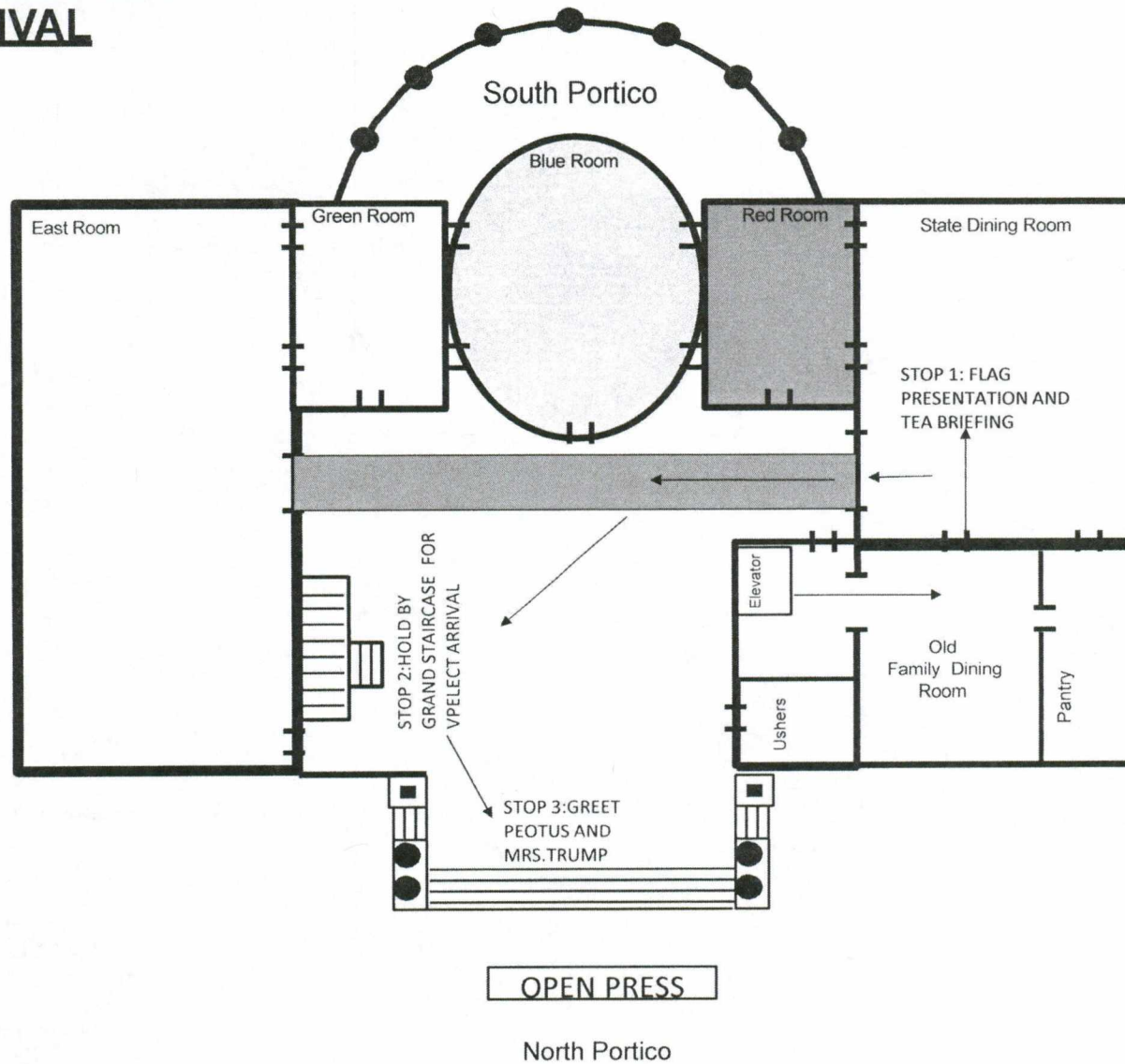
For 25 years, Leader Pelosi has represented San Francisco, California's 12th District, in Congress. She first made history when House Democrats elected her the first woman to lead a major political party. She has led House Democrats for 10 years and previously served as House Democratic Whip for one year.

Pelosi comes from a strong family tradition of public service. Her late father, Thomas D'Alesandro Jr., served as Mayor of Baltimore for 12 years, after representing the city for five terms in Congress. Her brother, Thomas D'Alesandro III, also served as Mayor of Baltimore. She graduated from Trinity College in Washington, D.C. She and her husband, Paul Pelosi, a native of San Francisco, have five grown children and nine grandchildren.

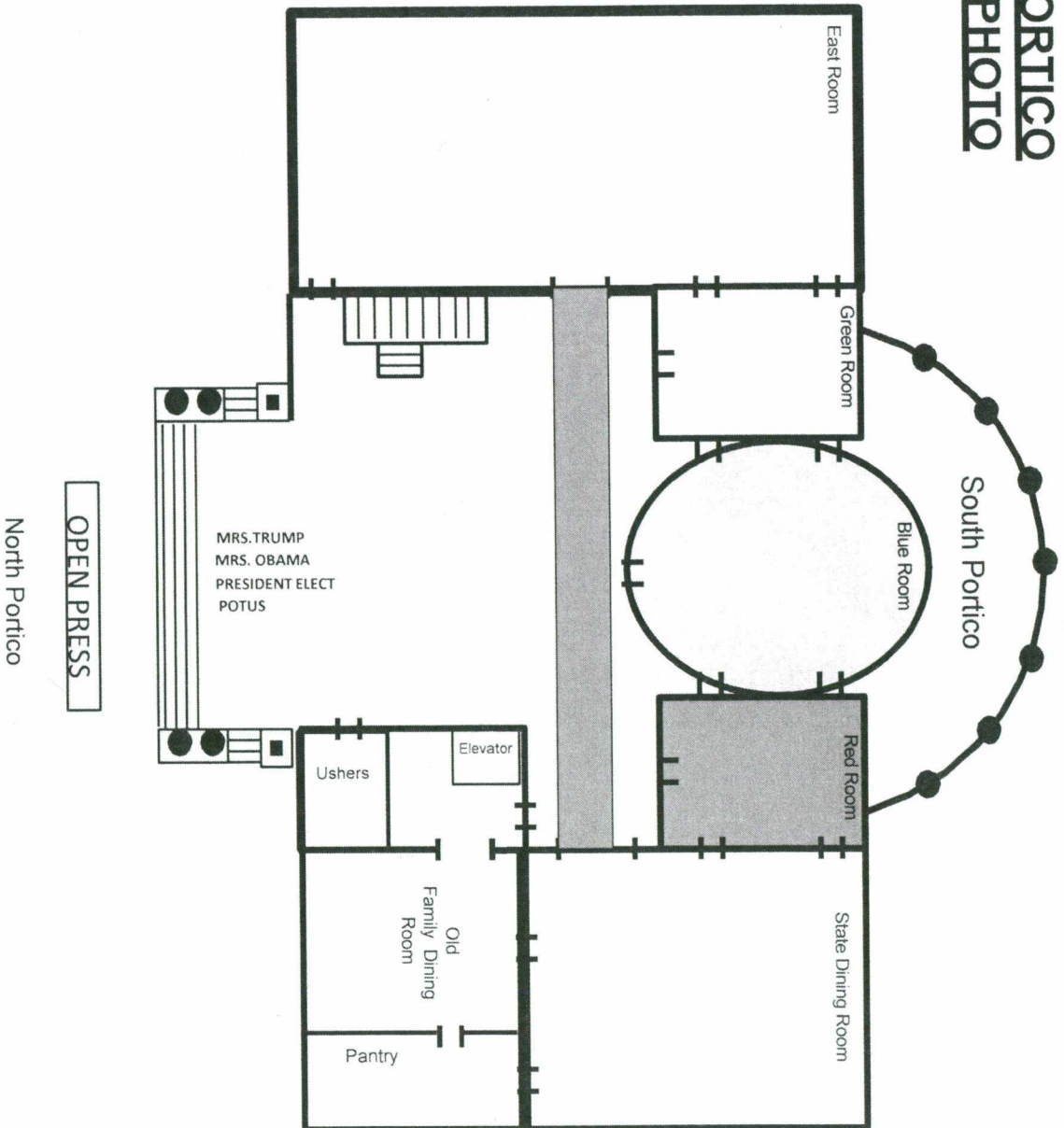

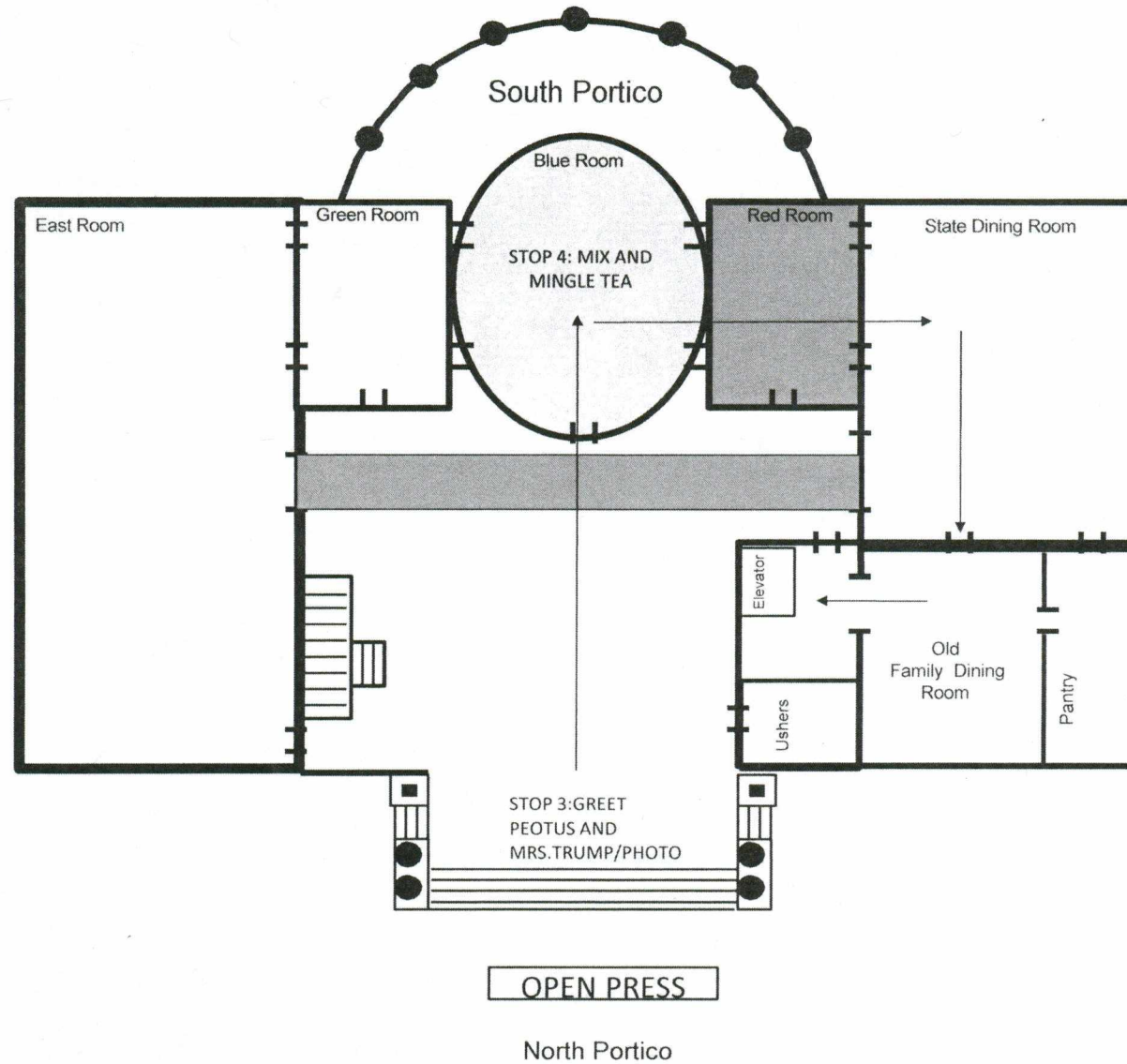
SLIDE 1 OF 4 - ROUTE FOR ARRIVAL



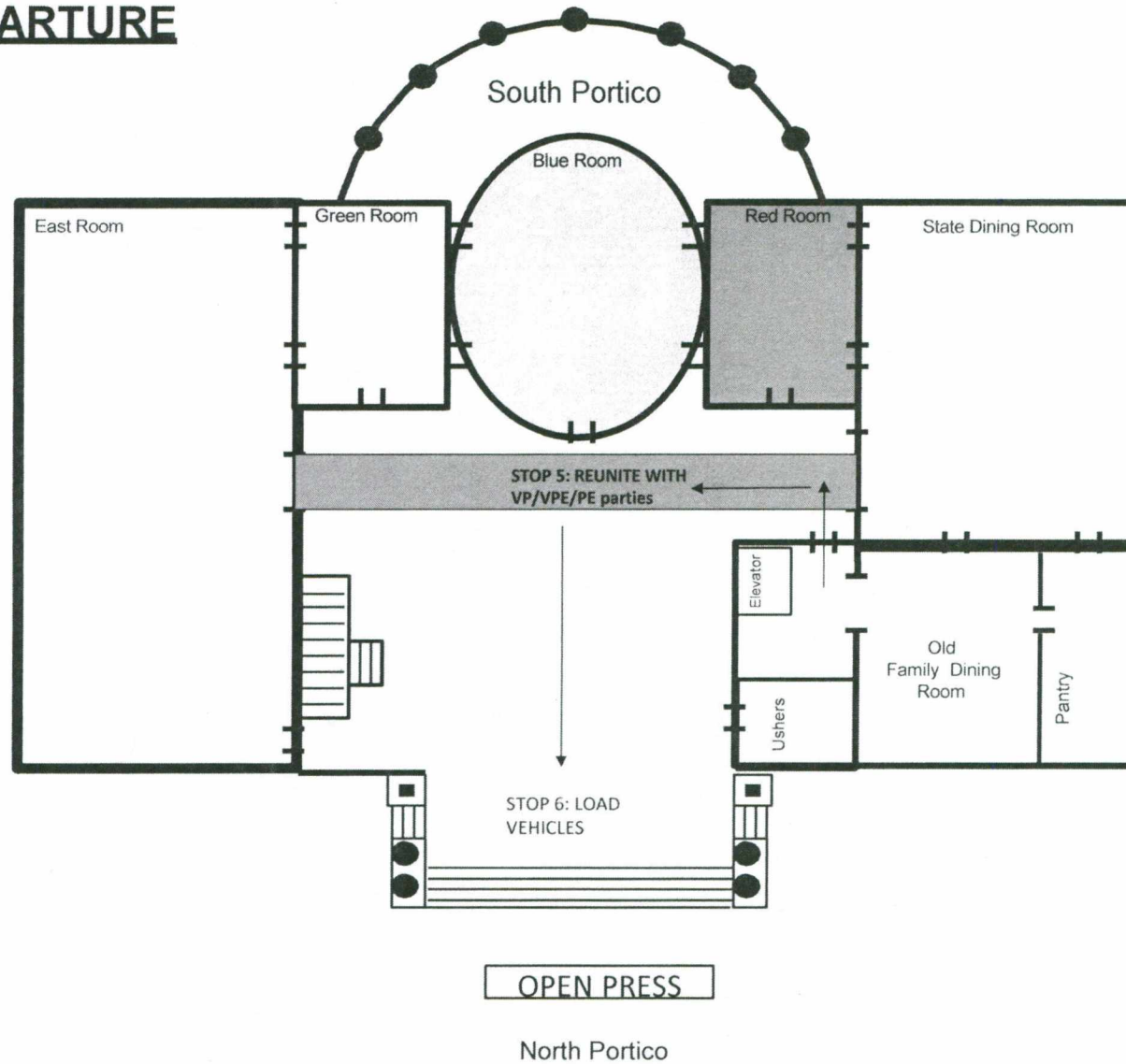
SLIDE 2 OF 4 -

BIOGRAPHIES

Colonel Casey Easton, 89th Wing Commander



Col Casey D. Eaton is the Commander, 89th Airlift Wing, Joint Base Andrews, MD. He is responsible for worldwide special air mission airlift, logistics, aerial port and communications support for the president, vice president, cabinet members, combatant commanders, and other senior military and elected leaders as tasked by the White House, Air Force chief of staff and Air Mobility Command. The wing provides 24/7 alert airlift and operates an Executive Airlift Training Center and Government Network Operations Center.

Col Eaton entered the Air Force in 1993 as a distinguished graduate of the Reserve Officers Training Corps program at Angelo State University in Texas. He has held various operational positions including C-17 Squadron Commander, Deputy Operations Group Commander and Wing Commander. Additionally, Col Eaton has served at Headquarters Air Force, Washington D.C., as a Deputy Division Chief in the Operational Requirements Directorate and as the Aide-de-Camp to the Secretary of the Air Force.

Prior to his current assignment, he served as Commander, 515th Air Mobility Operations Wing, Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Hawaii. There he provided forward-deployed command and control, aerial port, and aircraft maintenance support to DoD organic and contracted commercial aircraft executing airlift and air refueling missions throughout the Pacific theater.

Col. Julie A. Grundahl, Vice Commander of the 11th Wing



Col. Julie A. Grundahl is the Vice Commander of the 11th Wing and Joint Base Andrews-Naval Air Facility Washington, Md. The 11th Wing is the host wing for Joint Base Andrews-Naval Air Facility Washington, providing security, personnel, contracting, finance, and infrastructure support for six Wings, two Headquarters, and more than 50 tenant organizations, as well as 60,000 Airmen and families in the National Capital Region and around the world. The 11th Wing supports contingency operations in our nation's capital with immediate-response rotary-wing assets. It also provides security for the world's highest visibility flight line and is responsible for ceremonial support with the United States Air Force Band, Honor Guard, and Arlington National Cemetery Chaplaincy.

Colonel Grundahl was commissioned in 1995 after graduating with distinction from the U.S. Air Force Academy with a Bachelor of Science degree in Legal Studies. She commanded the largest operational rotary-wing squadron in the U.S. Air Force at the 1st

Helicopter Squadron, Joint Base Andrews-Naval Air Facility Washington, Md. She has also served in a variety of operational and staff positions, including Deputy Commander of the 11th Operations Group and Chief of the International Airmen Division, Deputy Under Secretary of the Air Force, International Affairs.

Colonel Grundahl is a command pilot with more than 3,600 flight hours and has deployed twice to combat locations as an HH 60G pilot conducting Combat Search and Rescue contingency operations.
