V. ADDITIONAL BACKGROUND

Founded in 2008, the Kastles have already won three World Team Tennis Titles and their current 32-0 winning streak is the second longest in US pro-sports history behind the 71'-72' Lakers. The team has won 7 matches by 1 game and saved 10 match points during the 32 match winning streak.

The Kastles were founded by Washington D.C. entrepreneur and philanthropist Mark Ein as a platform to give back and unite the Washington Community. Working with more than 200 local charitable, civic, and military support organizations, the Kastles have donated nearly \$1 million in cash and in-kind donations, including 8,000 match tickets and close to 5,000 tennis racquets.

Billie Jean King and her husband Larry originated the concept of team tennis in 1962. Twelve years later the first season started and the inaugural campaign started that included teams in sixteen cities ranging from Boston to Honolulu. The World Team Tennis spans 35-plus years with the involvement of some of the game's best-known personalities. Incorporating male and female players, the league has survived multiple incarnations and included teams from all across the country.

PARTICIPANT BIOGRAPHIES



Venus Williams, Player

After turning pro at age 14, Venus Williams is one of the most decorated Americans in women's tennis. Williams has won the singles title at Wimbledon, The U.S. Open and the Sydney Olympics. She has been ranked World Number 1 and is ranked World Number 35 in singles as of June 24, 2013. Venus started playing tennis at age 4, and was coached mostly by her father, who taught himself tennis from how-to-play books. She joined the Washington Kastles in 2012 WTT Finals Weekend September 15-16 in Charleston, S.C.



Leander Paes, Player

Leander Paes emerged on the Indian tennis horizon by winning the Wimbledon Junior title in 1990. Since then this tennis stalwart has been representing India at various international tournaments. Leander Paes started his tennis journey in the international tennis arena by winning the Wimbledon Junior title, making him the number one junior player in the world. He is the Captain of the Washington Kastles and is currently in his 23rd season as a pro. Paes helped lead the Kastles to the 2009, 2011 and 2012 Championship and was named the league's male MVP in 2011.



Anastasia Rodionova, Player

Anastasia Rodionova is a Russian-American professional female tennis player and the current Number 1 player in Australian doubles. She played her 5th team tennis season in 2013, which was her second consecutive with the Washington Kastles. In 2020, she achieved her career high rank of 62 in the world. She was a finalist in Wimbledon 2003 in mixed doubles. Rodionova started to play competitive tennis at age 7, but she was introduced to tennis much earlier. Her father Ivan was an amateur player so instead of toys, Rodionova had tennis balls in her pram.



Bobby Reynolds, Player

Bobby Reynolds will play his fourth consecutive season of Mylan WTT with the two-time defending champion Washington Kastles. He helped lead the Kastles to the 2011 and 2012 Championships, and was named Male MVP for the 2012 Mylan WTT season. He is currently ranked 149 in singles and 267 in doubles.



Mark Ein, Owner

Mr. Ein is the Founder and Owner of the Washington Kastles, his hometown's World Team Tennis (WTT) franchise. Mr. Ein is currently the Chairman of the Board of The District of Columbia Public Schools Education Fund (DCPEF) which seeks to attract private sector support for the DC Public

School System. Mr. Ein also serves on the Board of Directors of the United States Tennis Association (USTA), the District of Columbia College Access Program (DC-CAP), International Tennis Hall of Fame, the Executive Committee of the Federal City Council.



Kevin Wynne, General Manager

Kevin Wynne is the General Manager for the Washington Kastles, a position he has held since 2011. Kevin's leadership has been a key ingredient in the Kastles' 32-match winning streak.



Billy Jean King, Founder, World Team Tennis

Billy Jean King co-founded World Team Tennis (1974), the groundbreaking co-ed professional tennis league and founded the World Team Tennis Recreational League, one of the most popular recreational tennis formats in the U.S. YOU awarded her the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 2009. She is a member of the President's Council on Fitness, Sports and Nutrition and serves on the boards of the Women's Sports Foundation, the Andy Roddick Foundation and the Elton John AIDS Foundation.



Ilana Kloss, CEO/Commissioner, World Team Tennis

Ilana Kloss is a former professional tennis player and the commissioner of World Team Tennis. In 1974 she won U.S. Open juniors singles title and became the youngest player ever to be ranked Number 1 in South Africa. Kloss was ranked Number 1 in the world in doubles in 1976. That year, she won doubles titles at the U.S. Open, the Italian Open, the U.S. Clay Courts, the German Open, the British Hard Courts Championship, and Hilton Head, as well as the mixed doubles title at the French Open.



Murphy Jensen, Coach

Murphy Jensen will have led the Washington Kastles for five seasons in 2013. He helped lead the Kastles to consecutive undefeated championship seasons in 2011 and 2012, earning Coach of the Year honors in both 2011 and 2012. In his first season as coach of the Washington Kastles in 2009, he lead the team to their first championship.

Jennifer Spatz, Chief Operating Officer

Jennifer serves as the Chief Operating Officer of the Washington Kastles, managing the day to day activities for the team and at the stadium. Jennifer has been with the team since its founding in 2008.
