- YOU and the First Lady proceed to the Diplomatic Reception Room and take one group photo with the Dartmouth College Sing Dynasty (21 people).
- YOU and the First Lady take a photo with April Ryan (journalist, American Urban Radio Network) and her daughters.

- YOU and the First Lady depart the Diplomatic Reception Room and proceed to the Residence via the Usher's elevator.
- VOG announces YOU and the First Lady down the Grand Staircase into the Grand Foyer.
- YOU and the First Lady move to the podium on the stage in front of the North Portico doors.
- YOU deliver informal remarks.
- Following YOUR remarks, YOU and the First Lady work a rope line from LEFT to RIGHT to depart via the Ushers' Office.
 - NOTE: Rope line extends from base of staircase in front of the North Portico entrance to the Ushers' Office.
- YOU and the First Lady exit the reception through the Ushers' Office.
- YOU return to the Oval Office, the First Lady returns to the Residence.

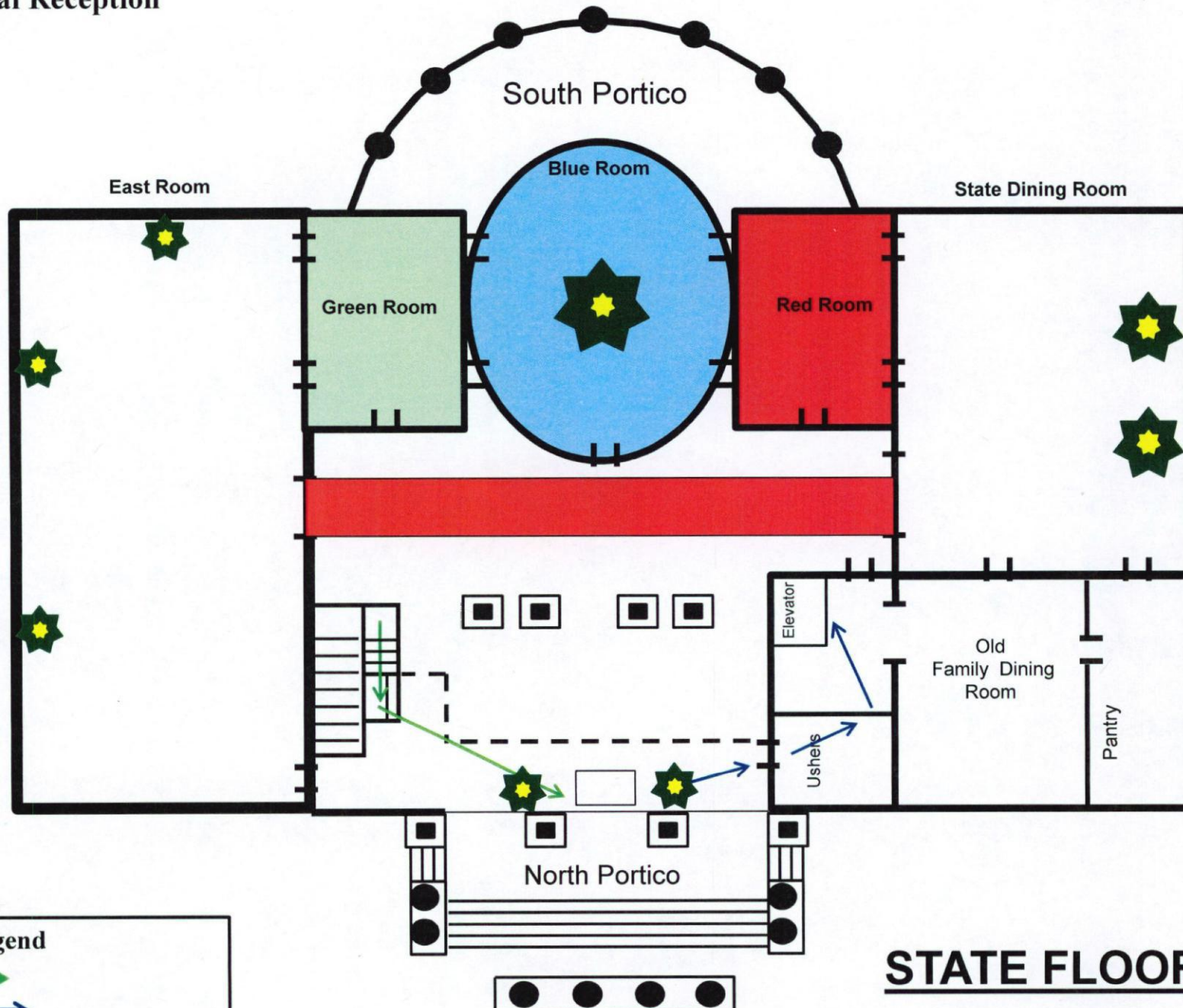

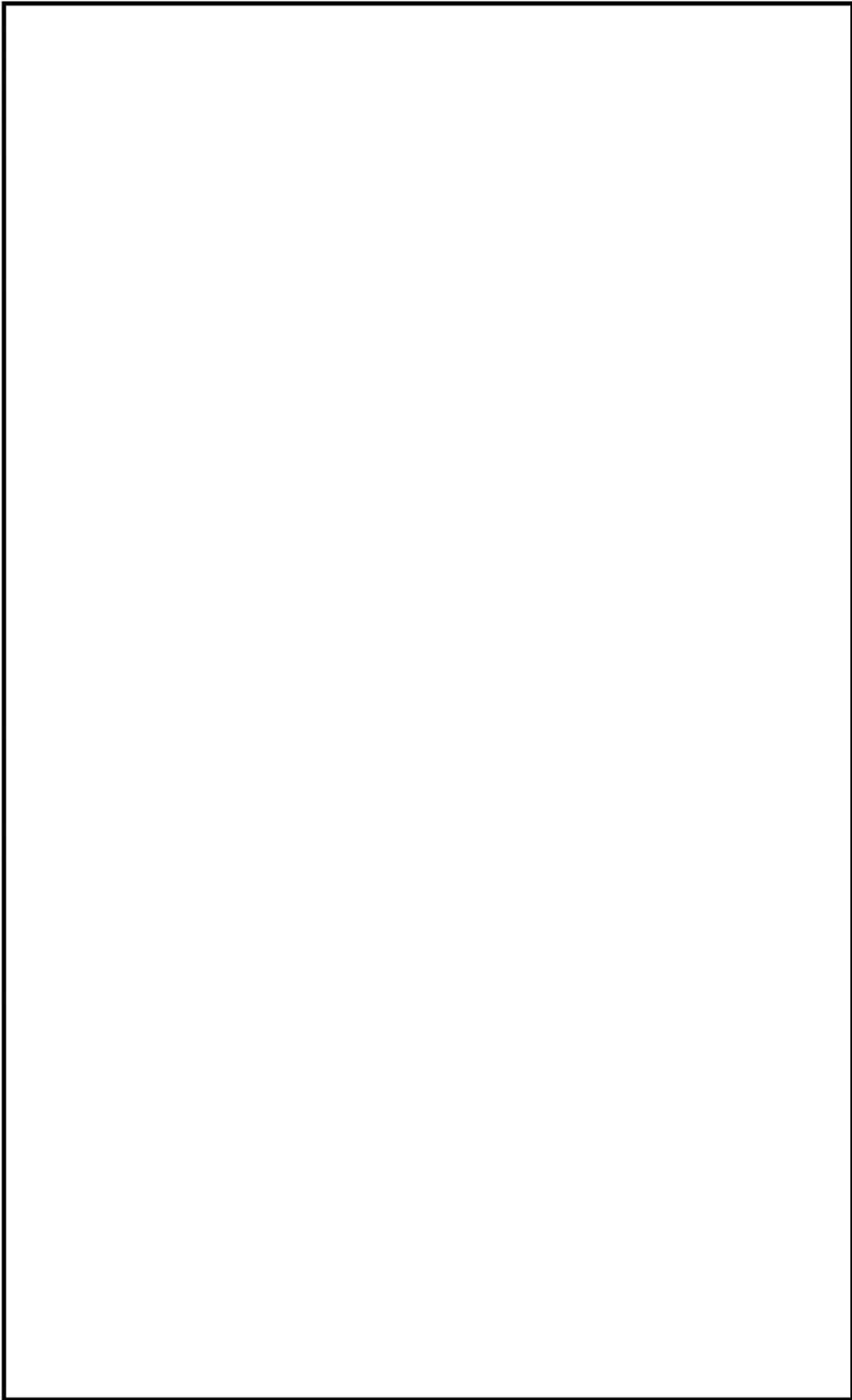

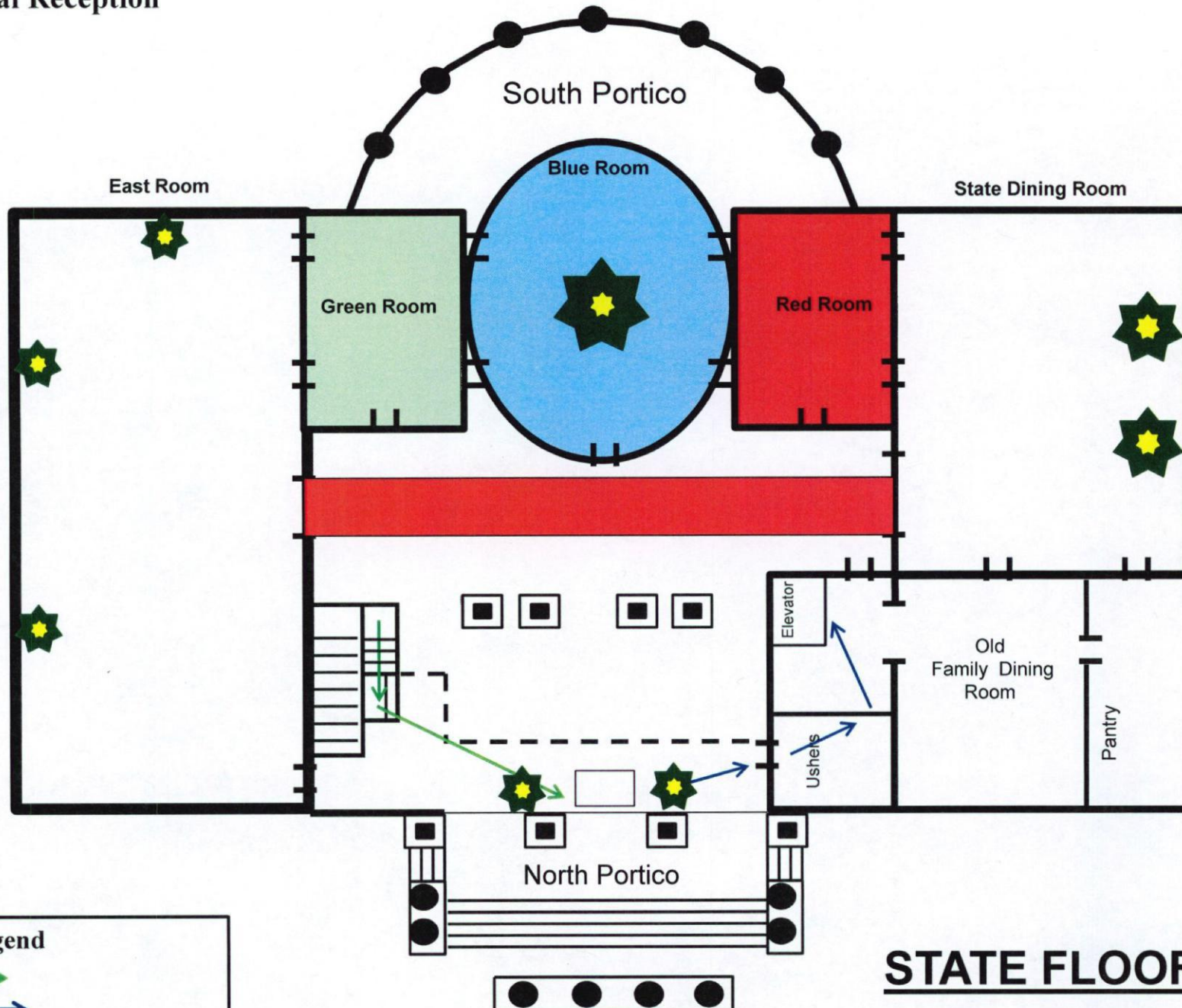
