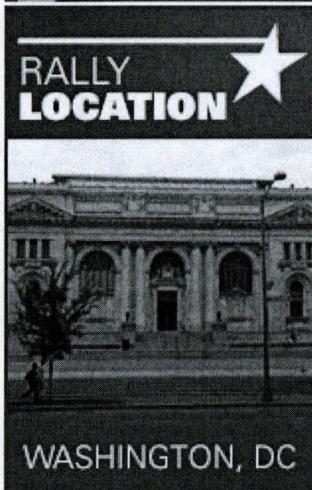
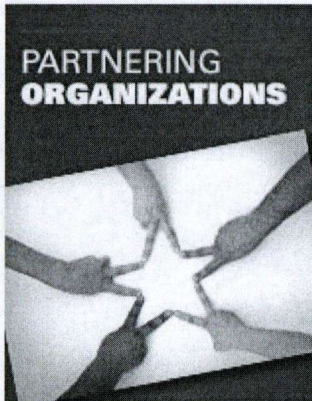
The Rally will be held on Monday, April 8 at 11:00 a.m. in Washington, DC, on the steps of the Carnegie Library.

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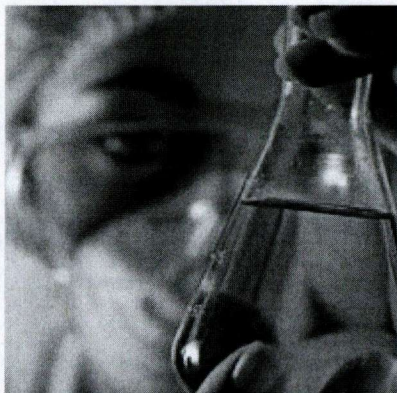

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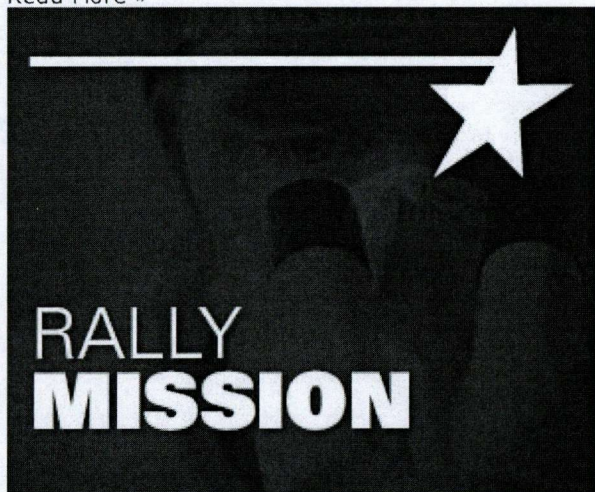

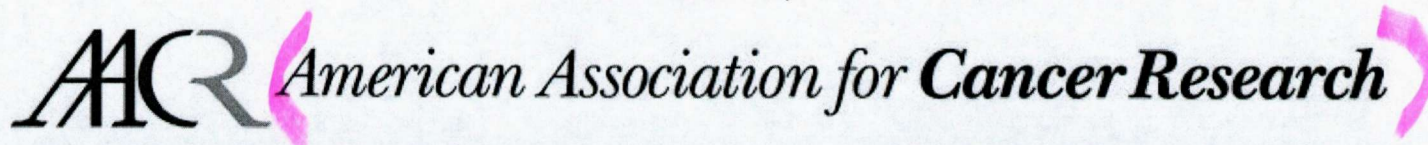

Before joining the AACR in 2010 as the managing director of science policy and government affairs, Mr. Retzlaff led the health and biomedical practice for a government relations firm in D.C. 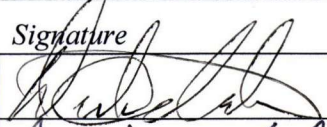
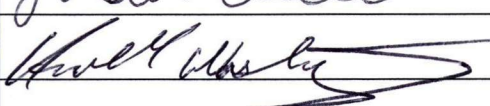
