#### WORLD'S FAIR CHINA

The New York World's Fair opened on April 30, 1939, the 150th anniversary of the first inauguration of President George Washington in New York City. The opening day address by President Franklin D. Roosevelt was broadcast by radio and television. When the fair closed in October 1940, tableware from the United States Pavilion was transferred to the White House, where it was used by Presidents Roosevelt and Truman. Most of the china, decorated with the Great Seal of the United States, was made by Shenango Pottery Co., Newcastle, Pennsylvania, under contract with Theodore Haviland. The service plate was made by Lenox in Trenton, New Jersey, the maker of the first American state service (Wilson) and five state services since.
