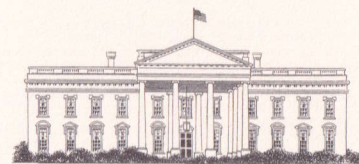

AMY GRANT

Amy Grant's career spans more than 30 years and stretches from her roots in gospel into becoming an iconic pop star, songwriter, television personality and philanthropist. With three multi-platinum albums, six platinum albums and four gold albums, her total career album sales have exceeded 30 million. In addition to her six GRAMMY® Awards, Grant has earned 26 Dove Awards (including four Artist of the Year Awards) and has been awarded a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame. Grant is the first Contemporary Christian artist to have a platinum record, the first to hit No. 1 on the Pop charts, and the first to perform at the GRAMMY® Awards.



HOWARD GOSPEL CHOIR

The HOWARD GOSPEL CHOIR (HGC) of Howard University was founded in the fall of 1968. With an active roster of seventy-plus persons, the choir is currently under the musical direction of Reginald Golden, a 2013 Howard University graduate. HGC's unique sound embraces both contemporary and traditional gospel, church hymns, Negro spirituals and classically arranged anthems. For the past four decades, HGC has set high standards as a premier performing arts ensemble. Throughout the exposure and success the main objective remains the same: to spread the Good News of Jesus Christ through song, and to serve Christ with their musical gifts bringing peace, restoration, healing and inspiration to all who will lend their ears and hearts.
